



US Congress

- State Governors/legislators every four years




Thankfully, they no longer look like this





Two candidates who are not on ballot competing for votes






Results US House of Representatives all 435

US Senate 34 seats (14 Dems, 20 Reps)


Democrats Win

Democrats have kept Senate control by flipping Pennsylvania and holding on to competitive seats in Arizona and Nevada.




Results Governors

Challenges


- Did the Democrats win? No


US economic growth

- Little control




Inward Looking










The Blue Homeland
